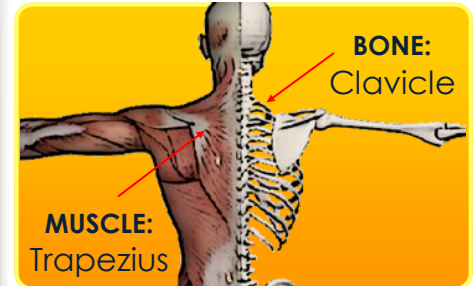
NO ASPHALT
